Arkansas Act 196, *AN ACT TO PROVIDE HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDERS*, was signed into law by Governor Mike Beebe on March 4th, 2011. This new law, which will require private group insurance policies to cover autism treatment and diagnosis, goes into effect on October 1st, 2011. Join us to discuss what the law covers and what we can expect in the coming months as the law is implemented.
